- All the sanctions/approvals and clearances shall be in place before 7. drawl of money from the treasury.
- A.O, Financial Commissioner, Revenue J&K, Jammu/Srinagar shall 8. vouchsafe the utilization of funds as per the Codal Procedure/Government of India guidelines.
- The Financial Commissioner, Revenue, J&K, shall incur expenditure 9. strictly as per the guideline of the scheme and the conditions laid down in the sanction letter of the concerned ministry of Government of India.
